Served as board chair of the Ford Foundation.

In recognition of his work in business and philanthropy, he was named a "Great American Immigrant" by the Carnegie Corporation in 2013.

Born in Ghana, West Africa, Appenteng began his education in England where he completed his primary and secondary education and then came to the United States to attend college at Wesleyan University.

Began his career as a corporate lawyer and, in 1994, became the first Black African to become a partner at a major New York City law firm.
